4. <u>Minor exemption request – 500 Hudson</u>

NOTE Councillor Colleen Feeney summarized the issues involved in the following matter. He also noted that it had been advertised in the newspaper. No comments were received since the publication (and none were made after these explanations).

It was moved by Councillor Elizabeth Ulin, seconded by Councillor Colleen Feeney and resolved:

That the plans and request submitted to the May 8, 2019 meeting of the Planning Advisory Committee be approved, in accordance with By-Laws 2010-002 and G-18-0005, for the following minor exemptions from section 4.1.6 and subparagraphs a) and c) of the third paragraph of section 4.9.1 of the Zoning By-Law, regarding the immovable located at 500 Hudson in Zone PC-1 to:

- Allow the construction of temporary buildings for a period of five years (60 months), while this type of installation is only authorized for a maximum period of one year (12 months), the consequence being to exceed this requirement by 48 months.
- Allow the construction of such temporary buildings without first obtaining a building permit for the extension of the main building, the consequence being to forego this requirement.
- Allow that these temporary building be attached to the main building, instead of being located at least two metres from the main building and one metre from each other, the consequence being to forego this requirement.

6. <u>Green Corridor Committee – appointments</u>

WHEREAS it is deemed advisable to bring together the various stakeholders;

WHEREAS a way to achieve this is to set up an advisory committee;

- 1) To set up an ad hoc Green Corridor Committee with a mandate to:
 - vehicle information;
 - · elaborate and reflect a common vision;
 - formulate recommendations to Hydro-Québec and to the Town.
