

TO SOLE OWNERS OF AN IMMOVABLE TO SOLE OCCUPANTS OF A BUSINESS ESTABLISHMENT TO UNDIVIDED CO-OWNERS OF AN IMMOVABLE TO CO-OCCUPANTS OF A BUSINESS ESTABLISHMENT

PUBLIC NOTICE is hereby given to the electors by the undersigned Returning Officer:

- to sole owners of an immovable and sole occupants of a business establishment, who do not already have the right to be entered on the electoral list as a domiciled person, that they may be entered on the electoral list for the current polling, provided that the following conditions are met:
 - 1. must be a physical person of full age on November 7, 2021;
 - 2. must be a Canadian citizen and not under curatorship as of September 1, 2021, and at this date, must not have been convicted, in the past five years, of an offence that is a corrupt electoral practice;
 - 3. must be the sole owner of an immovable or the sole occupant of a business establishment located on the territory of the municipality, since at least twelve months on September 1, 2021;
 - 4. must have transmitted to the municipality, at the address noted below, an application for entry on the electoral list at the latest on October 1, 2021;
- to undivided co-owners of an immovable and co-occupants of a business establishment, who do not already have the right to be entered on the electoral list as a domiciled person, or as the sole owner of an immovable or as the sole occupant of a business establishment, that they may be entered on the electoral list for the current polling, provided that the following conditions are met:
 - 1. must be a physical person of full age on November 7, 2021;
 - 2. must be a Canadian citizen and not under curatorship as of September 1, 2021, and at this date, must not have been convicted, in the past five years, of an offence that is a corrupt electoral practice;
 - 3. must be the undivided co-owner of an immovable or co-occupant of a business establishment located on the territory of the municipality, since at least twelve months on September 1, 2021;
 - 4. must have been designated in a power of attorney signed by the majority of co-owners or co-occupants who are electors on September 1, 2021;
 - 5. must have transmitted to the municipality, at the address noted below, an application for entry on the electoral list at the latest on October 1, 2021.

PLEASE NOTE that the application for entry or the power of attorney sent after October 1, 2021, but received no later than October 18, 2021 (last day to file a request with the Board of Revisors) will be considered as an application to amend the electoral list.

- You will have the opportunity to vote by mail if you are in one of the following situations:
 - You will be 70 years of age or older on polling day.
 - Between Sunday, October 17, 2021, and Wednesday, October 27, 2021, you must comply with a request or recommendation for isolation from public health authorities because you:
 - returned from a trip abroad within the last 14 days;
 - were diagnosed with COVID-19 and you are still considered a carrier of the disease;
 - are showing COVID-19 symptoms;
 - have been in contact with a suspected, probable or confirmed case of COVID-19 within the last 14 days;
 - are waiting for a COVID-19 test result.

To vote by mail, eligible electors must make a verbal or written request to the returning officer no later than October 27, 2021. If you are requesting to vote by mail because you must comply with an order or a recommendation from public health authorities to isolate, your request will be valid for the current poll only. If you will be 70 years of age or older on polling day, your application will be valid for the current poll and any recommenced proceedings arising from this election.
