

Notice of work

Sewer work near Meadowbrook creek

On the Meadowbrook Golf Course located on Chemin de la Côte-Saint-Luc

between November 15, 2021 and July 14, 2022

The city will be conducting work on the storm sewer that partly feeds the Meadowbrook creek, between November 15 and July 14. The work stems from a decision by the Court of Appeal of Quebec to cut off the flow of contaminated water into the creek. The creek is located on the Meadowbrook Golf Course.

The storm sewer located upstream from the creek is contaminated by wastewater from reversed plumbing connections. A reversed connection is when a building's wastewater (dish, bath and toilet water, etc.) runs into a storm sewer (rain water) instead of a sanitary sewer (waste water). The purpose of the work is to stop this water from running into the creek.

Nature of the work

The work involves:

- Extending the storm sewer by 250 metres, between the railway and Toe Blake Park on the golf course, and replacing the sanitary sewer.
- Building a dike (bank) near the railway to prevent contaminated water from the storm sewer flowing back into the creek.
- Doing some concreting work inside the manhole located in Toe Blake Park, over approximately one week.

The work will not affect **the quality of your drinking water or your sewer service**.

Tree work in the construction area

Some trees will have to be cut down because their survival is compromised by the work, while others will be pruned to avoid damage from the machinery. Upon completion of the work, any cut trees will be replaced with other trees, deciduous shrubs and vegetation.

Impact of the work

There is no impact expected on traffic, building access, garbage and recycling collection or parking.

Noise

- Generators and fans will be used 24 hours a day, on an ad hoc basis, for a few weeks during the concrete pours, to seal the storm sewer connection joints.
- A pump will be used 24 hours a day during work on the sanitary sewer to maintain its flow.

The work will be carried out Monday to Friday, from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m.
