# 4. <u>Capital funding campaign for a Recreation center – discount brokerage account opening (Royal Bank of Canada)</u>

WHEREAS the Town of Montreal West has launched a capital funding campaign for the purpose of providing its contribution to the project for a new Recreation and Community Center which is already benefitting from a government subsidy;

WHEREAS one of the ways citizens and corporations might be willing to contribute is by the gift of stock options or other transferable securities;

WHEREAS the monies that the Town may receive in this way must be invested in accordance with section 99 of the Cities and Towns Act;

WHEREAS the Town has inquired on how this can be done;

#### THEREFORE:

It was moved by Councillor Colleen Feeney, seconded by Councillor Lauren Small-Pennefather, and resolved:

- 1) That the Town of Montreal West open a discount brokerage account with the Royal Bank of Canada to receive any options and securities donated towards the Recreation Center project.
- 2) That the Town, to abide with section 99 of the Cities and Towns Act, take the necessary steps to cash these options and securities without delay.
- 3) That the Treasurer be authorized to sign all necessary documents for the purpose of this resolution.
