Avenue Westmore, Rue Sherbrooke Ouest and Chemin Broughton



Traffic and parking

- Chemin Broughton : Complete closure from September 26 between Brock Sud and Westminster Sud until winter break.
- Avenue Westmore : Work continues until winter break.
- Rue Sherbrooke Ouest : Work continues until the end of October.

- To ensure safety and optimize travel during work, please obey all signage (detours, local traffic, speed limits, etc.)
- The contractor is required to provide a secure site perimeter and may use parking spaces to store materials or equipment. Check the signage in the area, it can be modified if necessary.
- Some operations may be postponed or extended due to unforeseen circumstances or adverse weather conditions.
- If you believe that a situation requires special attention and that it would be appropriate to inform the site manager, call 311.

Information about the project



- Schedule: Monday to Friday, 7 a.m. to 6 p.m.



- Service interruption: A poster distributed 48 hours in advance to the doors of affected buildings will show the date, time and duration of water supply interruption.
- Owners whose water service lines will be replaced have already been notified and will be contacted by the contractor as needed.



- If a part of a private lot is affected, it will be restored to the condition it was in prior to construction.



- On collection days, place your trash cans and bins, clearly identified with your address, in the usual location. Containers that are inaccessible to garbage collectors will be moved by the contractor.



- Construction may be postponed or extended due to unforeseen circumstances or adverse weather conditions.
- For each project, a team of experts will plan measures to mitigate noise, vibrations, dust and odours caused by the use of tools and other construction equipment.

Where is the site crew?



Managing site crew is an integral part of project planning. During stages that require a break (paint drying, concrete curing, asphalt cooling, etc.), or that are not carried out in the field (repairing a part, testing drinking water, etc.), workers are temporarily assigned to another project.
